Aloha and Mahalo for your interest in participating as a Food Vendor in Nevada's largest Polynesian Festival. We would like to provide you with important information and requirements for acceptance into our esteemed event.

Event Location:

The Rio Casino and Hotel

Festival Days and Times:

- Thursdays, April 23rd, 2026: 5 pm – 11 pm
- Friday, April 24th, 2026: 5 pm – 11 pm
- Saturday, April 25th, 2026: 1 pm – 11 pm
- Sunday, April 26th, 2026: 1 pm - 10 pm

General Information / Non-Permitted Items & Restrictions:

- No subleasing booth space.
- Food Trucks may be considered based on space availability. (please inform vendor coordinator of possible usage)
- Food Trailers will be considered based on placement of trailer and/or available space. (please inform vendor coordinator if using a trailer)
- Vendors must operate under the listed NAME or DBA on the vendor application.
- ALL vendors must be open and operating throughout the entire duration of the event. Starting from the specific opening times of each day until the specific closing times of each night. Please see the dates and times listed above. Early closures and/or not operating at the start of the event will result in penalties.
- **Vendors are not allowed to sell any beverage.**
- All displays or products must be confined within the allotted booth space.
- Prior approval required for promotional materials.

Application Process and Acceptance:

- Applications accepted until Friday, April 10th, 2026 or Sold Out (whichever comes first)
- Acceptance is not guaranteed; applications reviewed on a first-come, first-served basis.
- No duplicate *MAIN food items* allowed; approval needed for menu items.

Nevada Business License

- The State of Nevada requires all vendors to provide proof of a Nevada Business License.
- Nevada residents may apply for a Nevada Business License.
- Please include your Business License Number on your completed application. You must also submit a copy of your Nevada Business License when turning in your application.
- If you DO NOT have a Nevada Business License, please indicate on your application.

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Health and Safety Requirements:

- Obtain a Temporary Food Establishment (TFE) Permit from the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD).
- Provide a copy of your TFE permit *receipt* to Pure Aloha's vendor coordinator as soon as payment is complete with SNHD.

Fire Department Requirements:

- Portable fire extinguisher with a minimum rating of 40B in every food booth.
- Class K fire extinguisher within 30-feet of each grease-producing appliance.
- Class 2A-30BC fire extinguisher within each booth for various cooking applications.

Nevada Department of Taxation:

- Sales tax requirement; a temporary "One-time Sales Tax Permit" form will be provided with your vendor packet at vendor check-in.
- One-Time Sales Tax form along with payment, will need to be completed and returned to the vendor coordinator at the end of the event at vendor check-out. Pure Aloha CDC will send it in on your behalf.
- Self File vendors will still need to turn in their One Time Sales Tax form, with their signature along with "Self File" printed on the amount paid line, and turned in at vendor check-out.
- If you sell at more than two events in Nevada during a twelve-month period, you must register with the Department of Taxation and obtain a Sales & Use Tax Permit.

Vendor Booth Placement:

- For a \$50 fee you may choose your vendor spot. Very limited on the amount of vendors that will be able to pay the fee and pick their spot. Picking your spot will be based on who pays for their booth in full with the added "choose your spot" fee. Ask the vendor coordinator for more details.
- We will do our best to accommodate any requests made aside from those who will be paying to choose their booth. No guarantees for specific placements unless you are confirmed that you may pick your spot.

Temporary Power

- One 20-Amp outlet per Food Vendor booth purchase.
- Approval required for electrical items.
- Purchasing additional power if needed is an option as well.
- Surge protectors required; not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged equipment.
- Temporary Power operates two hours before opening and one hour after festival closure.

Additional Canopies and Rentals:

- One additional canopy allowed, placed behind the given canopy, and not exceeding 10' x 10'.
- Open flames must be at least 20' away from **any** canopy.
- Rentals available for tables, chairs, and sidewalls only.
- Vendor responsible for providing their own Wi-Fi for their POS systems.

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Booth Cleanliness and Cleaning Deposit:

- All food vendors are required to provide a \$150 cash refundable cleaning deposit at the time of check in.
- Cleaning deposits will only be returned if your booth was inspected prior to leaving the event on the last day of the festival.
- Vendors who do not get their booth inspected and fail to check out will forfeit their deposit and not have it returned.
- Deposits will be given back at the end of the event when you check out, as long as you are cleared during the check-out process.

Vendor Confirmation:

- Confirmation letter sent via email, if your application is accepted, full payment must be made by or before Monday, April 13th, 2026.
- Vendor Packets will be distributed at vendor check-in. It'll include receipt of invoice, vendor check-in details, dates and times of set up & break down, vendor parking pass, vendor wristbands, Hold Harmless Agreement, & One-Time Sales Tax form.
